Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.

Jeremiah 33:3

God Hears Your Prayers

This beautiful promise reminds us that God invites us to come to Him in prayer. No matter what situation we face or who we are praying for, we are never speaking into silence. God hears every prayer spoken with faith and an open heart.

When someone you love is going through a difficult time, it can sometimes feel helpless. But Jeremiah 33:3 encourages us to bring those worries, fears, and hopes directly to God. Philippians 4:6–7
