Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.

1 John 4:8

God Is Love

1 John 4:8 tells us something simple, yet incredibly powerful: God is love. This means that love is not just something God shows it is who He is. Everything God does flows from His perfect love.

When we struggle to understand God, this verse gives us a clear starting point. God is not distant, harsh, or uncaring. He is loving in His nature, patient in His ways, and faithful in His heart toward us.

His love is not based on our performance or perfection. It is steady, unchanging, and always available. Even in moments when we feel uncertain or far away, God's love remains constant.

To know God is to begin to understand true love a love that restores, forgives, and never lets go.

And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, “The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness,

Exodus 34:6

God is compassionate and gracious

Exodus 34:6 is one of the most beautiful and important descriptions of who God is. In this verse, God reveals His own character: compassionate, gracious, slow to anger, and overflowing with love and faithfulness.

This shows us that God’s heart is not quick to judge or punish, but full of mercy and patience. He sees our struggles, understands our weaknesses, and responds with kindness rather than rejection.

To be slow to anger means that God is patient with us, giving us time to grow, change, and return to Him. His love is not limited or temporary it is abundant and faithful, reaching into every part of our lives.

When we wonder what God is like, this verse reminds us that He is a God who meets us with grace, surrounds us with love, and remains faithful no matter what.

**Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the one who takes
refuge in him.**

Psalm 34:8

God is good

Psalm 34:8 invites us into something personal: Taste and see that the Lord is good. This is more than just understanding who God is it's about experiencing Him for yourself.

God's goodness is not distant or abstract. It is something real, something you can encounter in your everyday life. In moments of peace, in times of need, and even in challenges, God reveals His kindness, care, and faithfulness.

Lamentations 3:22–23

God is faithful

Lamentations 3:22–23 reminds us of a powerful truth: no matter what we face, God's love never runs out. His compassion does not fail, and His mercy is renewed every single day.

The Lord is near to all who call on Him, to all who call on Him in truth.

Psalm 145:18

God is near

Psalm 145:18 gives us a comforting promise: The Lord is near to all who call on Him, to all who call on Him in truth. This reminds us that God is not distant or unreachable. He is close, present, and attentive to those who seek Him.

**This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you:
God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.**

1 John 1:5

God is light (pure and holy)

1 John 1:5 tells us: God is light; in Him there is no darkness at all. This powerful truth reveals God's pure and perfect nature. There is no evil, no sin, and no darkness in Him only truth, holiness, and goodness.

Proverbs 3:5–6
