Perfect Peace Comes from a Steadfast Mind

Sleep in God's Safety and Peace

God's peace brings rest. When your mind is racing or your heart is heavy, remember that the Lord is your safety. You can sleep in peace knowing He's watching over you.

God is the source of peace, and He gives it freely in all times and all ways. Whether in silence or in storms, His presence brings a peace that endures.
